## **Boundary Correction Order** *Minnesota House of Representative Districts 50A and 50B*

Hennepin County requested that the Secretary of State act under Minnesota Statutes, section 2.91, subdivision 2, to order a correction to the boundary between Minnesota House of Representative Districts 50A and 50B, for the reason that the boundary between the two districts is not properly named and is ambiguous.

The legislative boundary currently follows the municipal boundary with exception of one census block that encompasses only a highway cloverleaf, census block 270530259051004. The remainder of the legislative district follows municipal or physical boundaries.

Because this legislative district boundary is ambiguous and not properly named in the Special Court Redistricting Panel's description, this request meets the requirements of the Minnesota Statutes, section 2.91, subdivision 2. In order to resolve the ambiguity in favor of creating districts of convenient, contiguous territory of substantially equal population, I exercise my authority under Minn. Stat. § 2.91, subd. 2, to order a correction and correct the boundary between Minnesota House of Representative Districts 50A and 50B. The boundary is now to follow the municipal boundary between the cities of Edina and Bloomington, placing census block 270530259051004 in District 50B. As census block 270530259051004 has zero population, this will not impact the population of each district.
