Boundary Correction Order

Minnesota House of Representative Districts 51A and 63B

Hennepin County requested that the Secretary of State act under Minnesota Statutes, section 2.91, subdivision 2, to order a correction to the boundary between Minnesota House of Representative Districts 51A and 63B, for the reason that the boundary between the two districts is not properly named and is ambiguous.

The legislative district boundary currently does not follow a municipal boundary or a physical feature. Instead, the legislative boundary crosses just north of the municipal boundary and splits part of a highway. The remainder of the legislative boundary follows municipal or physical boundaries.

Because this legislative district boundary is ambiguous and not properly named in the Special Court Redistricting Panel's description, this request meets the requirements of the Minnesota Statutes, section 2.91, subdivision 2. In order to resolve the ambiguity in favor of creating districts of convenient, contiguous territory of substantially equal population, I exercise my authority under Minn. Stat. § 2.91, subd. 2, to order a correction and correct the boundary between Minnesota House of Representative Districts 51A and 63B. The boundary is now to follow the municipal boundary between Minneapolis and Richfield, as it passes through census block 270530120036018. As census block 270530120036018 has zero population, this will not impact the population of each district.
